ORGANIC WASTE

What belongs in the organic waste bin?

Compostable kitchen and garden waste, e.g.:

- **Fruit and vegetable waste** (raw)
- **Tea bags and coffee filters**
- **Absorbent paper** (e.g.: paper for wrapping wet kitchen waste)
- **Potato peels**
- **Potted plants** (without pot)
- **Bread crusts**
- **Grass cuttings**
- **Leaves**
- **Tree, hedge and bush trimmings**

The following should NOT be put in the organic waste bin, e.g.:

Cooked food →	Where? →	General waste bin
Meat remnants →	Where? →	General waste bin
Fish remnants →	Where? →	General waste bin
Milk products →	Where? →	General waste bin
Bones →	Where? →	General waste bin
Foil →	Where? →	Yellow bin
Nappies →	Where? →	General waste bin
Toiletries →	Where? →	General waste bin
Cigarette ends →	Where? →	General waste bin
Pet litter (small quantities) →	Where? →	General waste bin
Sweepings →	Where? →	General waste bin
Glossy paper →	Where? →	Paper container

Please **do not put organic waste in bin bags or plastic bags** in the organic waste bin. Use newspaper to line your kitchen waste bin and for wrapping damp organic waste
